**Order No : D1-48449/2019/ID Dated. 18-10-2019**

The 16 th session of 14th Kerala Legislative Assembly will commence from 28.10.2019 onwards. In obedience to the directions contained in the orders under reference, an LAI Cell is here by constituted at the District Police Office, Idukki with immediate effect with the following members under the chairmanship of DYSP DCRB Idukki. **Overall supervision of the LA cell will be with Addl.SP (Admin)** . The cell will ensure prompt and timely replies to all LAI's without fail. Similarly, all the Sub Divisional Police Officers shall ensure that the LAI cells are functioning at all police stations under his jurisdiction and they will report the data to District LAI cell then and there. Also ensure that one responsible officer should present in all Sub Divisional Offices including night hours for attending LAI's. **The Administrative Assistant, DPO Idukki shall personally ensure the service of ministerial staff for providing data to the LAI cell. All Junior Superintendents should personally ensure that the replies from their branches are promptly reaching the LAI cell functioning in DCRB and JS's will be personally responsible for any delay in this regard. The Manager DPO shall depute one ministerial staff for each days LAI duty for the entire LAI session. The ministerial staffs of LAI shall not be allowed to leave office without the permission of the undersigned or the Addl.SP.** The officers concerned will be held responsible for any delay, supply of incorrect data etc. in this regard. In case of retirement/transfer of the members in cell, the successor will normally be included in the cell without awaiting any further orders. The instructions envisaged in the orders under reference should be strictly adhered to.

LAI cell should be operative round the clock, including holidays. IAPS & Email facility should be utilized to ensure time limit . Fax machine and telephone should be made operative round the clock on all days with a suitable hand to operate. Receipt of replies sent to PHQ/SBCID Headquarters should be confirmed over telephone also. Apart from LAIs, Submissions, Calling Attention Motions and Adjournment Motions etc on various issues may come up during the Session. One DySP conversant with the past and present issues in the district should be available at given telephone numbers in the LAI cells from 6.30 AM onwards on all Assembly days to furnish replies on Submission/Adjournment motion/Calling Attention Motion etc. to the higher offices. Full details regarding Law and Order, Communal and other sensational developments occurred after the last session should be collected by the LAI cell and kept in hand for answering questions. Details regarding answers to possible questions may also be collected in advance and kept ready for avoiding delay. DySP in charge of LAI Cell should ensure that replies containing statistics are verified with similar replies sent in previous LA sessions . DySPS of DCRB and Dist SBs should be present in their office from 7AM during the assembly sessions. They should contact DySP, SPMR, SBCID Headquarters from their office telephone every day at 7 AM and will inform anything of importance noticed on the



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previous day. Similarly, all DySPs should be present in their respective office and will contact SP (Int) or DySP, SPMR from their office telephone, if any important development crops up. Any laxity or unavailability of responsible officers will be dealt with seriously.

It will be the collective responsibility of all the members of LAI cell to collect, consolidate and send the replies of LAIs on time. The LAI cell will maintain a register at DCRB under the supervision of a Sub Inspector. The cell will function 24 x 7 bases and one of the Four DySPs in the LAI Cell should be available in their office round the clock during the entire LAI Session. A duty roaster will be maintained by the DySP, DCRB, Idukki for turn duty arrangements as ordered by the undersigned. All replies to State level LAI cell should be furnished in Malayalam and time limit should be strictly adhered too. All the replies to LAIs should sent only through PHQ.
